In the 1960s Abraham Megerdichian began making pans, knives, candle holders, and flower vases for use at home. As he became a more skilled machinist, Abraham began machining intricately detailed everyday objects out of blocks of brass, aluminum, copper and stainless steel, which he presented to his family as gifts for holidays.
